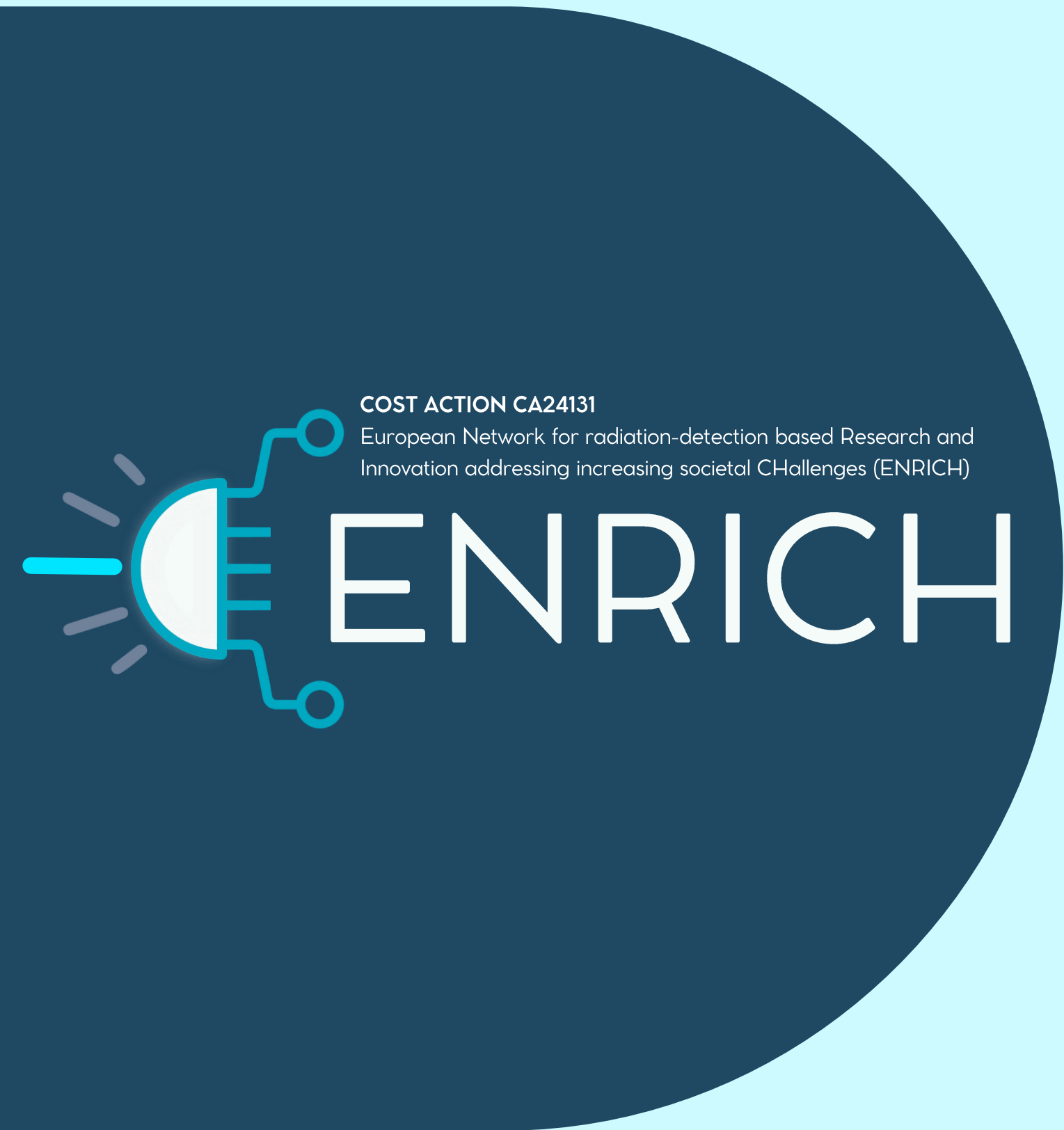

Research activities

Research and development of X-ray imaging detectors based on the photoluminescence of radiation-induced electronic defects in lithium fluoride.

Main features: high spatial resolution (standard sub-micrometric scale, intrinsic nanometric scale) over a wide field of view, extended dynamic range.

Applications: contact X-ray imaging in absorption contrast (including *in vivo cells*) and phase contrast; X-ray laser beam diagnostics, including X-FEL; characterization of X-ray optics (zone plates, polycapillary optics).

Research and development of advanced materials such as graphene-based composites (for Space and Cultural Heritage).

Expertise in advanced confocal optical microscopy and spectroscopy, and Raman micro-spectroscopy.

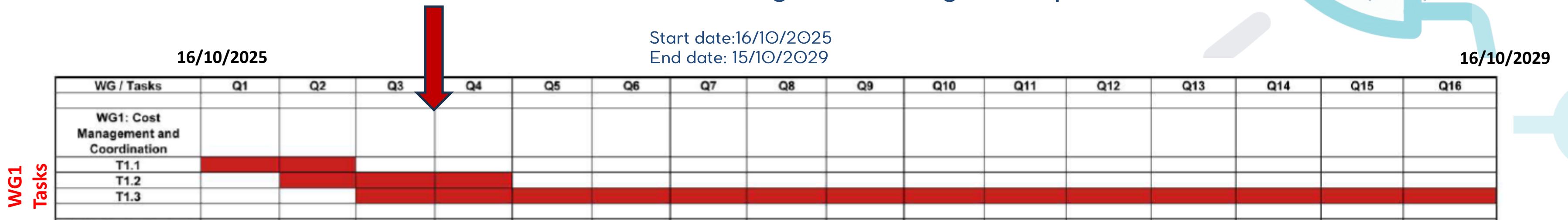
WG1 : Community Coordination

Research Coordination Objectives

RCO1: Build an overtime increasing broad and multidisciplinary community that includes experts, institutes, laboratories, and stakeholders across fundamental, atomic and nuclear physics, astrophysics, environmental science, biology, life sciences, detector development, solid-state physics, imaging, medical physics, raytracing simulations, agrifood, material science, nuclear forensic, radiation security, cultural heritage, optics, photon sources, and electronics. This includes cataloguing existing but unconnected sub-communities.

Capacity-Building Objectives

CBO1: Serve as a transnational stakeholder platform to gather and disseminate state-of-the-art knowledge in radiation detection fields, including fundamental, atomic and nuclear physics, astrophysics, environmental science, biology, life sciences, detector development, solid-state physics, imaging, medical physics, raytracing simulations, agrifood, material science, nuclear forensic, radiation security, cultural heritage, optics, photon sources, and electronics. This CB aims as well to gather and disseminate information on infrastructures, research groups, and manufacturers.

CBO2: Engage COST Inclusiveness Target Countries (ITC), new research groups, and teams from countries with less capacity, ensuring gender balance and supporting young researchers to provide equal access to scientific and technological knowledge.

CBO3: Strengthen collaborations among leading international scientists in radiation-related fields to develop a joint research agenda.

M3 - WG Annual Meetings (Q4, Q8, Q12, Q16): These meetings will be done in presence and will gather active participants of the various WGs to review, plan and organize the tasks and the activities of each year. These meetings will be opened to the representatives of the various stakeholders involved in each WG.

M4 - Final Conference (Q16): This will be the conclusive event of the ENRICH Action, where all the results will be presented and the pathways and recommendations for future works will be discussed.

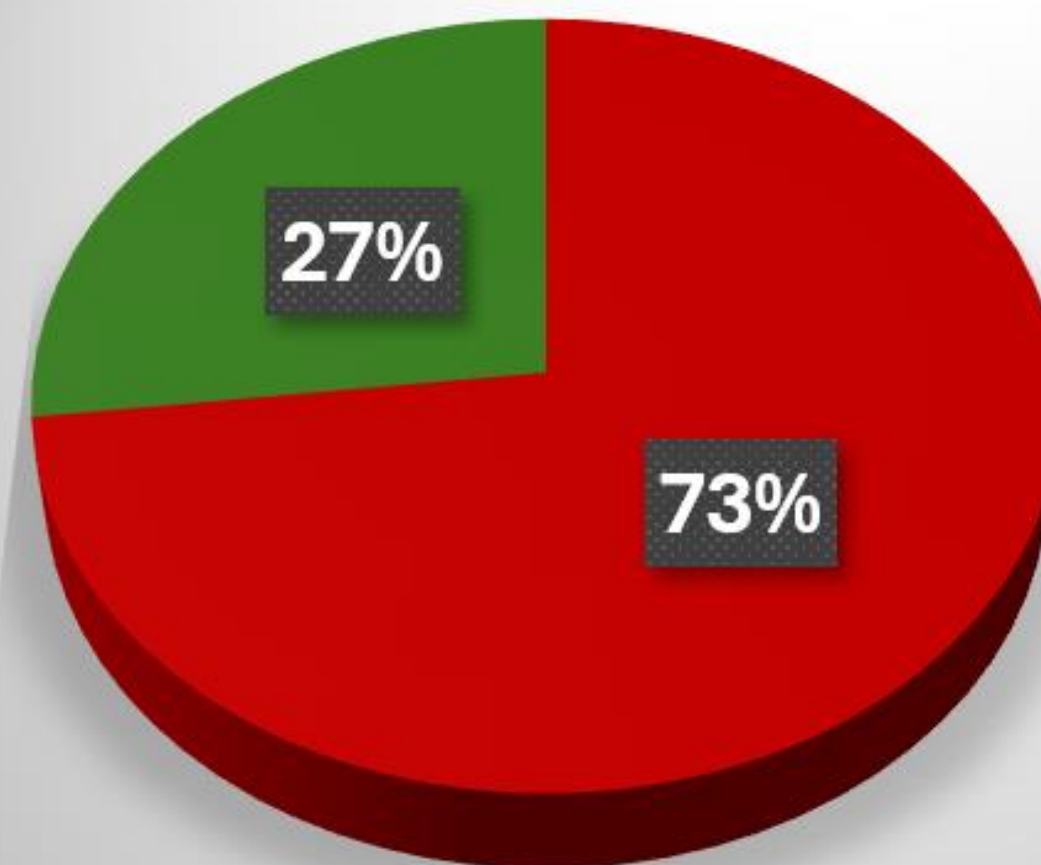

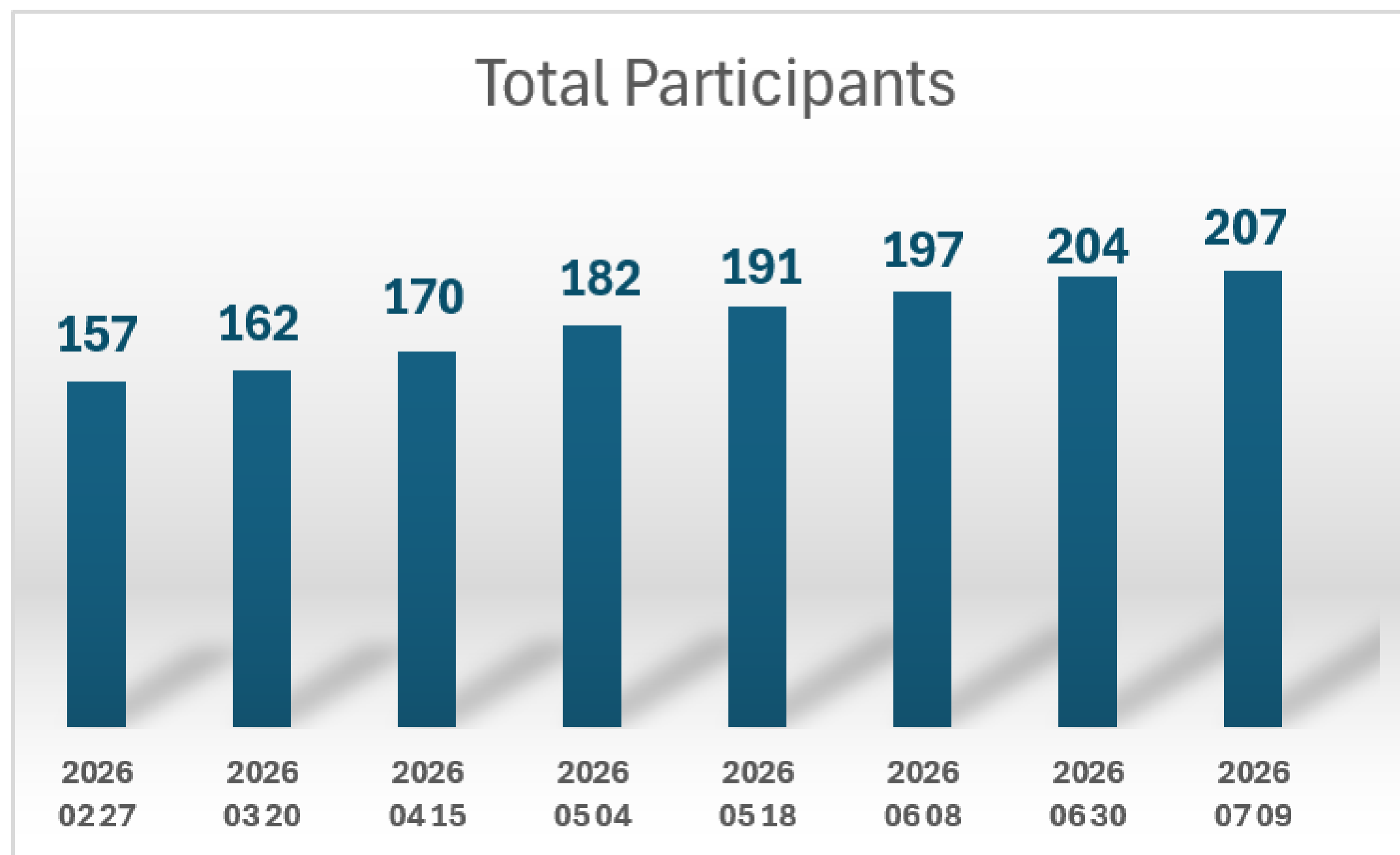
